## HEALTH INSURANCE

UE members : the students who present the EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) are exempted to purchase a French students health insurance.

For the private european insurance there are acceptance conditions : being name specific (to cover the student and/or the members of his family) Cover the university full year (from 01/09/17 till 30/09/18). Be translated into French. And without tariff limitation or ceiling.

Students will have the opportunity to buy French students health insurance the cost is about € 215 a year.
