PRACTICAL INFORMATION

ACCOMODATION

Students will receive an email regarding finding housing and a housing list when they receive their acceptance letter. Please note that RU does not have student housing and students are ultimately responsible for finding housing. We have been experiencing a shortage of housing in the Reykjavik area, and we therefore ask you to forewarn students that housing can be difficult to find and will require quite some effort on their behalf to secure housing. We provide as much assistance as possible, but the market is limited.

MONTHLY RENT COST (APPROX):

ISK 70.000 – 90.000 per month (please check the latest ISK/EUR exchange rate). Based on a room in a shared house, including electric, heating and usually wifi (this can vary).

LIVING COSTS (APPROX):

Approximately ISK 70.000 per month (not including housing). Varies greatly depending on individual life style.

NON EU/EEA CITIZENS:

Citizens of countries outside the EEA need to apply for a residence permit. Please note, the visa application takes around 90 days. [Visit our website for further information.](#)
