<p>Application procedures</p>	<p>Once nomination is accepted by the DRI, students will receive an email with a link to the online application form.</p> <p>Students will be asked to complete the online application and upload the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ID photo - Learning Agreement/Study Plan (*) - Certificate of French and/or English proficiency (*) issued by the home university's language center (or similar). <p>Application Deadlines</p>	<p>Deadline for receiving exchange student applications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Autumn Semester and Full academic year: 1st May - Spring Semester: 15 November. <p>Please note that unfortunately we cannot process any late applications.</p>
<p>Academic Calendar</p>	<p>The academic year is divided into two semesters:</p> <p>Semester 1 (Autumn): September to January</p> <p>Semester 2 (Spring): January/February to June</p> <p>Summer school for exchange students: 2 weeks from mid-August to beginning of September.</p>
<p>Arrival Dates</p>	<p>During the week prior to the beginning of the semester/ for the summerschool.</p>
<p>Orientation Dates & Academic Fair</p>	<p>Individual orientation by our Exchange coordinators a few days before the beginning of courses.</p>
<p>Entry Requirements</p>	<p>In order to apply for the Inbound Exchange Program you must satisfy the following criteria: Minimum 2 years of full-time study at a partner university</p>

<p>French Language courses</p>	<p><u>Induction period</u></p> <p>French intensive Language is given during the Induction period (22,5h/week) = 2 ECTS. All Exchange students must pay the €75 fee for French courses and cultural activities during Induction period.</p> <p>More information on: https://www.insa-rouen.fr/international/programmes-internationaux/ecole-dete-ecole-dhiver-file</p> <p>To apply, please send an e-mail to: summerschool@insa-rouen.fr before 1st June and ask for the “Summer school/ induction period enrolment form”.</p> <p><u>French courses during the year</u></p> <p>French courses given to all Exchange students during the year are free of charge. 1h30/week – 14 weeks = 2 ECTS/semester.</p>
<p>Accommodation at INSA Rouen Normandie</p>	<p>Campus at Saint Etienne du Rouvray/Madrillet</p> <p>INSA Rouen Normandie provides on-campus accommodation for all exchange students: €300 to €400 per month.</p> <p>Le Havre Campus (Civil Engineering Department)</p> <p>INSA Rouen Normandie does not have residences in Le Havre but we can help students to find accommodation (Agreements with CROUS and Housing Association in Le Havre).</p> <p>To apply for student housing, students just have to tick the box in the on-line application form. <p>Health Insurance</p>	<p>Before arrival</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students from EU countries: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) - Students from Québec: SE 401 Q 106 form - Students from non-EU countries: Non-UE Exchange students must take out a health and accident insurance policy prior to their arrival in France and valid until October 1st 2019 (Autumn Semester) or March 1st 2020 (Spring Semester). <p>All students coming to attend the Induction Period must have their own health insurance covering them from their arrival to August 20th 2019.</p> <p>On arrival</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students from non –EU countries: mandatory registration to the French Student Social Security (free of charge). <p>For more information, please contact the International office: international@insa-rouen.fr</p>
<p>Entry formalities in France</p>	<p>Citizens of the European Economic Area and Switzerland: valid national identity card or passport</p> <p>Other nationalities: passport valid for the duration of the stay + a visa</p> <p>Visa Application procedure</p> <p>They are issued by the consular services of the French Embassy in your country of origin. Most have adopted the CEF procedure.</p> <p>Find out if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>You need a “short stay” visa</i> (stay less than 90 days). Cost of the visa: 60€. If you obtain a “short stay” visa, there are no other formalities to complete once you arrive in France. - <i>You need a “long stay” visa</i> (stay longer than 90 days). Cost of visa: 90€ <p>For the validation of your “long stay” visa (VLS-TS), we help you to constitute your file at your arrival at INSA Rouen Normandie!
