Upon request many professors are willing to teach in English! It is also strongly recommended to attend a German course during the exchange period. At least we expect a profound knowledge of English language from the students. The Interface Culture master program is taught in English!

Accommodation

Accommodation	Our university does not have on-campus accommodation. To help students find accommodation, our Austrian National Agency (OeAD) offers a lodging service. Health insurance

It is obligatory to have a sufficient health insurance valid in Austria during the exchange. Students have to take care of an appropriate health insurance themselves.

National health insurance (stay for longer than 3 month):

If students **are from an <u>EU/EEA country or Switzerland</u>**, it should be sufficient to bring the e-card with them.

Students who have valid **national health insurance** in their home country can obtain a <u>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</u> from their health insurance provider in their country of origin upon application. With this card they will have access to all medically necessary public health services in Austria (at the same conditions and the same costs). Find more details on the <u>website</u>.

Health insurance requirements

If students **are a <u>"national of third countries"</u>** (i.e. not EU/EEA or Switzerland), they need a health insurance which is valid in Austria.

In principle <u>travel health insurance</u> must be taken out to enter Austria with a visa (and for the whole duration of your stay). Please note that this insurance must be valid in Austria and provide sufficient cover for various health issues (insurance cover well over 30,000 Euro including guarantee to cover possible recovery and repatriation costs).

The Austrian Student Union's fee from about Euro 20,-- per semester (compulsory for all students enrolled at Austrian Universities) covers a liability insurance and an accidence insurance for damages and accidents in the University's sites and on the way from home to the University – http://www.ufg.ac.at/Health-Insurance-Care.10761.0.html



Visa

EU / EAA / Switzerland:

If students are a national of an <u>EU/EEA country or Switzerland</u> they do not need a visa. If they have sufficient financial means to finance the stay in Austria and valid health insurance covering all the necessary costs, the students only need <u>a valid travel document</u> (passport or identity card) in order to enter and become resident in Austria.

If students are staying in Austria for **more than three months**, they have to inform the competent residence authority in Austria in person **within four months** and apply for a confirmation of registration ("Anmeldebescheinigung"). Attention: Non-compliance with this regulation can lead to a fine of up 250 Euro! This registration is required in addition to the registration with the <u>registration</u> office.

Entry to Austria

Nationals of Third Countries

If students **do not have EU/EEA or Swiss nationality**, they are a "national of a third country" and they **will need an entry or residence permit** in order to enter or become resident in Austria.

Students have to make visa arrangements by themselves!
