3. Nomination and Application Procedure

- 1. The e-mail nomination to <u>erasmus.incoming@ug.edu.pl</u> from the Partner University Coordinator is required. Following, the home coordinator is obliged to register a student in our online Registration System(ESRS).
- 2. Consequently, at registration, student receives an e-mail with the application procedure and the individual link to ESRS to upload all the required documents.
- 3. When student is registered he/she receive e-mail with instruction about application procedure.

4. Courses in English

7. Language of instruction

Polish, English

Language requirements: no formal English language competence certificate required.

Each student is asked to provide the English Language Confirmation during the application.

The English Language Confirmation is a document that has to be signed by a person from the home university (English lecturer, Coordinator) who is authorize to confirm that the English language competency of a student meets the requirements agreed in the Inter-institutional agreement between our universities. The form is available to students who are registered in our online registration system.

A Complimentary course of Polish Language is offered to all Erasmus Incoming Students at the Beginner's level during the semester.

9. Accommodation

The University of Gdansk offers a limited number of residence rooms in our dormitories. Upon completing the application procedure all eligible Erasmus Incoming Students receive the e-mail instructions on how to apply online for a housing in one of university dormitories. The application system works on – "first come, first served basis "so it means that not every student might be provided a dormitory place.

10. Health insurance

An <u>EU Erasmus student are required to have</u> a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) issued at their home country (valid for the entire period of their stay at the UG).

A <u>non-EU Erasmus student are required to have</u> the commercial health insurance policy (valid for the entire period of their stay at the UG) which provides coverage for medical expenses, treatment, cost and assistance for transportation.

For all incoming students is recommended to have a Personal Accident Insurance Plan.

Health Insurance Card will be verified after arrival.

If students do not have valid HIC they will be denied studying under Erasmus exchange at the University of Gdansk.
