Universidad Politécnica de Valencia (UPV), founded in 1971, is a public institution devoted to higher education, and to research and development (R&D) activities. The main scientific and technological domains are information and communication technologies, electric, electronic, mechanical and chemical engineering, civil engineering, architecture, food and agricultural technologies, business sciences and fine arts.

UPV has four campus sites: Vera and Blasco Ibañez (inside the city of Valencia), Alcoy and Gandia, with a total of over 35,000 students, 2,600 teaching staff, and 1,900 administrative and support staff members. UPV budget for 2007 was over 354 M€ The UPV runs its R&D policy towards two aims: On one side, as a young university, the UPV needs to foster strategic and pre-competitive R&D to strengthen its basic knowledge base. For such purpose, it moves its research groups towards the major European research priorities, especially within the European R&D Programmes. On the other hand, it has a special vocation to perform R&D of interest to our industrial environment, looking after being a technological and R&D partner to companies settled in this region. In this sense, through technology transfer, the UPV gets closer the market's technology demands and obtains funding for further own R&D activities.

Description of the expertise (max 2.000 characters)	<p>We have worked on the study and development of Emergency Management Systems since 1998. Then, we started a project with MetroValencia to build a hypermedia version of its Emergency Plan. Since then, we have pursued the improvement of Emergency Plans by increasing the use of ICT. Specifically, we have studied the dimensions of Emergency Management, and defined a spectrum of technologies associated to each dimension. We have strong cooperation with the GRECO research group at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (Brazil), which is involved in several projects at national and international level related to the field of Emergency Management. Our joint work has dealt with aspects like knowledge management in emergency responses, definition and assessment of the maturity levels of organizations related to emergency management, use of flexible processes to specify coordination in emergency responses, and the use of digital libraries as part of the ICT infrastructure for emergency response and management.</p>
